

Ford Alan Mulally Leadership in Engineering Scholarship 2018-19

The Alan Mulally Leadership in Engineering Scholarship, was established by Ford Motor Company to honor the former President and CEO of Ford. The scholarship award is in the amount of \$10,000 to an outstanding Sophomore or Junior in the College of Engineering, at the University of Michigan.

Eligibility

To be considered for the Alan Mulally Scholarship, a student must meet all of the following criteria:

- Current Sophomores or Juniors enrolled full-time in the College or Engineering. (Year 2 or 3)
- Students must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA.
- Majors related to Automotive Engineering. Preferred majors; Mechanical, Electrical or Computer Science Engineering
- Leadership role in academic or community based settings. (ex. With campus organizations, community volunteer work, or other engineering related activities).
- Eligibility is restricted to United States citizens or permanent residents.

Application Evaluation

Applicants will be evaluated on the strength of their academic performance, proficiencies, demonstrated leadership skills, interest in the automotive industry, and essay quality.

Selection Procedure

For the 2018 – 2019 academic year, all completed applications that are submitted no later than the close of business on Tuesday, April 3rd, 2018 will be reviewed against the program criteria by a College of Engineering scholarship committee. All applicants will receive notification of the selection committee's decisions.

- Complete and sign the attached application.
- Attach a current resume.
- Attach a one page essay regarding your interest in Automotive Engineering, Leadership role(s) held, and why you're a strong candidate for this scholarship.
