

# Leinweber Software Scholarship Program 2015 – 2016

## Description

The Leinweber Software Scholarship Program provides financial awards to outstanding undergraduate students that are enrolled as full-time students at the University of Michigan. A limited number of scholarships are awarded through this program.

## Purpose

Larry D. Leinweber and his family seek to enlarge the pipeline of Computer Science Engineering talent to enable and support the growth of the software industry in the State of Michigan.

## Eligibility

To be considered for a Leinweber Scholarship, a student must meet all of the following criteria:

- Sophomore grade level in the College of Engineering for new awards. Junior or Senior for renewed awards.
- Majoring in Computer Science and Engineering.
- Michigan resident as determined by the University of Michigan's Office of the Registrar.
- Interest in working in the software industry after graduation, in the State of Michigan.
- Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Eligibility is restricted to United States citizens or permanent residents.

## Selection Procedure

For the 2015 – 2016 academic year, all completed applications that are submitted no later than on Tuesday, December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015, will be reviewed against the program criteria by a scholarship committee determined by the College of Engineering. All applicants will receive notification of the selection committee's decision.

## Application Instructions

- Complete and sign the Leinweber Software Scholarship application.
- Attach a one page essay regarding your interest in working in the Michigan based software industry after graduation.
- Submit the application to the College of Engineering's Scholarship Office at the address on the application form, by 5:00 PM, EDT; on Tuesday, December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015.
