### Applicant Criteria

- Applicants must be pursuing a bachelors or master's degree.
- Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time each semester.
- Applicants must be planning to attend, or be actively attending, University of Michigan, Purdue University, North Carolina State, Wayne State University, University of Massachusetts – Lowell, Clemson University, University of Akron, Georgia Institute of Technology or California Polytechnic State University (San Luis Obispo campus).
- Applicants must be planning to pursue, or be enrolled in, Mechanical Engineering or a Materials (Polymer) Science curriculum.
  - University of Akron applicants MUST be majoring in Chemical Engineering with a Minor in Polymer Science.
  - University of Massachusetts – Lowell applicants may also be enrolled in Plastics Engineering.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- Applicants must demonstrate traits of high personal character and leadership.
- Scholarships designated for recipients from a socially disadvantaged background are available. Applicants will be prompted to write their personal statement on their socially disadvantaged circumstances.
